In 1944, Heifer International sent 15 heifers by ship to struggling families in Puerto Rico. That shipment of animals was a start of a new life for those families.

Today, Heifer ships some 20 different animals to impoverished areas of the world where they provide nutritious food to those in need through milk, eggs or meat. Heifer project families can use the money they make from selling animal products to pay for housing, health care, school fees and other needs. Heifer also provides seeds and trees to help make environmental improvements.

The Falls Village Congregational Church is one of many churches that is on board with the Heifer project; a project that we see as an opportunity to help change hundreds of lives.
